Kari Lake to visit Oregon for Constitutional Carry fundraiser

SALEM, OR—July 7, 2023—Constitutional Carry for Oregon (CCFO) is bringing the fabulous Kari Lake to Salem for a fundraising reception Saturday, July 29, 5-8 p.m. The evening also serves as a stop on her *Unafraid* book tour. Proceeds from ticket sales help CCFO continue on the offense to protect Second Amendment rights in Oregon.

Lake is a former television news anchor and nationally known GOP nominee for governor of Arizona.

Two categories of tickets are available. Extreme VIP tickets allow pre-event access at 5 p.m. with a guaranteed photo, personally autographed book and discussion time with Ms. Lake. Only six Extreme VIP tickets are for sale. Standard VIP tickets secure entrance to the event at 6 p.m. and an autographed copy of *Unafraid*. Guests can enjoy mingling with Kari and other guests, and will then listen to this dynamic speaker.

IP-21 amends the Oregon Constitution with the addition of one simple sentence: "... includes the right to carry, without a permit, a concealed firearm." At present, 27 U.S. states are already constitutional carry states.

CCFO has until July 5, 2024, to submit 160,551 signatures for IP-21 to appear on the November 2024 general election ballot. CCFO is a grassroots volunteer effort. The three chief petitioners are: Joel Pawloski, a retired Army Lt. Colonel in Marion County; Kerry McQuisten, the former mayor of Baker City in Baker County; and Jean Sampson, former city council member of Clatskanie in Columbia County.
